The Galapagos Sea Star Journey has a capacity of 16 passengers; it features seven spacious Galapagos Suites (25m2= 270 ft2). Five suites are twins, allocated between the main (2 suites) and the upper deck areas (3 suites). Some of these Galapagos Twin Suites can be converted in Matrimonial through a faux king bed.

The main deck twin suites have a balcony, and the others on the upper deck are interconnected, so they are ideals for families. All the suites are equipped with panoramic windows to enjoy the landscapes of the islands, private bathroom, hot/cold water, air conditioning with independent controls, and safe box.

First Aid

- PeptoBismol or Kaopectate for stomach upset and mild diarrhea.
- Immodium or Lomotil for more severe diarrhea

- Aloe Vera cream or gel for sunburn
- Tylenol or other mild pain relief

- \square Sun block lotion
- PABA sunscreen (at least # 15) take lots, you will run out. The sun is very very hot here.
- ____ Lip salve
- \square Sunglasses with a strap
- → Extra eye glasses/ contact lenses
- \neg Insect repellent, this is essential!
- → Personal medication
- _____ Self-sealing bags for electronic equipment
- → Digital Camera, either point and shoot or SLR will work well.
- Underwater cameras to take photos of the animal life while snorkeling (take a few you will use them fast!)
- → Camera gear
- Enough flash memory to download pictures / memory cards, don't underestimate how many photos you will take, some people come back with over 2000 in 4 days!
- → Binoculars in case you want to get a more detailed look at unique animals in Galapagos.
- \square Extra batteries for cameras

IMPORTANT NOTE: Since April 2018, the Galapagos Islands is plastic free. For this reason, it's not allowed to use and bring disposable plastic bags, straws, plastic bottles, and plastic food containers. Please, take into consideration this policy when you are traveling to the Enchanted Islands.
